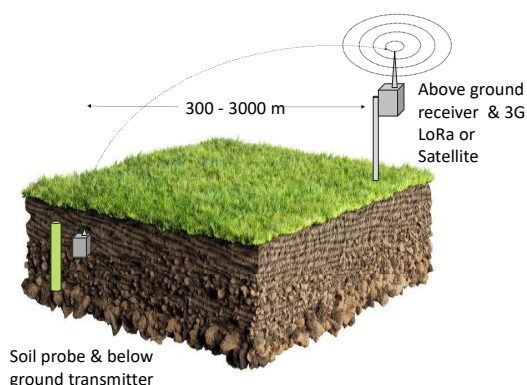


Our purpose

Features

- The BILBY® is a below ground wireless data node that sends data from soil moisture sensors to an above ground receiver up to 100m to 1000m away
- Eliminates the need for above ground in-paddock wires and solar panels
- Prevents damage to sensors from marauding tractors, stock, and wildlife
- Transmission distance depends on topography, soil moisture, soil type and depth of installation
- Compatible with EnviroPro and Sentek probes
